Parties tribunal bars Kega faction from Azimio divorce

Wrangling officials ordered not to transact any business on behalf of party

The Political Parties Dispute Tribunal has barred the Jubilee faction led by EALA MP Kanini Kega from pursuing

H President Uhuru Kenyatta while the ya Kega faction has declared support for President William Ruto and his Kenya Kwanza administration.

The Kega faction had kicked out Uhuru as party leader and replaced him with nominated MP Sabina Chege while Kega became the acting secretary general replacing Kioni.

Kioni, vice chairman David Murathe and Kagwe Gichohi were subsecuently expelled from the party

In a ruling made on June 16, PPDT halted a move until a case filed by Secretary General Jeremiah Kioni is heard and determined.

The wrangling Jubilee officials have also been ordered not to transact any business on behalf of the party until a case lodged at the Political Parties Dispute Tribunal is heard and determined. rathe and Kagwe Gichohi were sub-sequently expelled from the party. In the matter filed before the tribunal and which has since been certified urgent, Kioni wanted the Kega faction stopped from making decisions on behalf of the party. He also wanted their alleged ex-pulsion revoked and that his faction recognised as the bonafide party of-ficials

Kega camp had written to the Azimio la Umoja Coalition notifying the leadership of the withdrawal notice. In a statement, Kega said the decision was arrived at following a National Executive Committee meeting held on June 6. Jubilee Party has two warring factions led by former Ndaragwa MP Kioni and Kega.

Kioni's faction is loyal to former

The tribunal stopped both factions from making any pronouncements or resolutions on behalf of the party until the case is heard and determined. "That pending the hearing and determination of the com-
